About us!

The Child Cancer Foundation aims to reduce isolation and the impact of cancer through offering and coordinating support services that ensure children and their families are well cared for, supported and informed at every stage of their cancer journey.

More than three children on average per week in New Zealand are diagnosed with cancer. Each year New Zealand children with cancer collectively undergo an astounding 75,000 treatments and procedures throughout their journey. For each one they receive a Bead of Courage...

The government does not contribute to the \$5 million required each year for child and family support services. The Foundation therefore relies completely on the generosity and support of New Zealanders to fund the practical, emotional and financial support services to children and families facing child cancer in New Zealand.

What we do

We are dedicated to helping brave kids with cancer and their families, ensuring that they never feel alone.

The Foundation provides families with:

- An assigned Family Support Coordinator on diagnosis
- Face to face support in hospital and in the community
- Education and development support through the Foundation's scholarship programme
- Information resources and school support
- Support Health Professionals financially
- Parent Support Programmes - a link to other families
- Some financial assistance through difficult times
- Access to Child Cancer Foundation Family Places, activities, programmes
- A nationwide Branch network
- Coordination with other organisations and community support groups
- Advocacy for special needs of children with cancer and their families
- Holiday homes and respite

Make sure you set yourself a fundraising goal, why not try and raise \$500 or over!

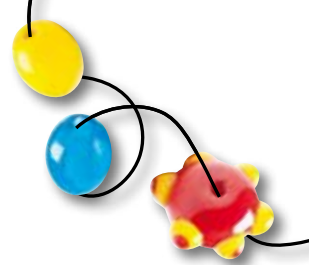

YOU ONLY NEED TO USE THIS BOOK IF:

- A) you have set up a fundraiseonline page but people want to give you cash or cheques, and need a receipt.
- B) you don't have access to the internet and won't be setting up a fundraiseonline.co.nz page.

LIST List your sponsors on the forms provided.
HINT - It's easier to collect your pledges as you go (before the event). That way you won't have to chase lots of people afterwards.

COLLECT Collect your sponsorship money (either cash, or cheque made out to Child Cancer Foundation). Tick the received box when someone pays you. If they have sponsored more than \$5.00 and ask for a receipt, highlight their details clearly in this pack*

BANK Bank all your money once it is collected in ONE deposit at any Westpac Bank and deposit into the Child Cancer Foundation funrazor account as described OR using online banking – more details are on the inside back cover of this booklet.

RETURN Return your sponsorship forms WITH your deposit receipt from Westpac firmly attached to:

Here's how it works!

- 1** Now you've registered, ask all your friends, family, colleagues, fans... everyone you know to sponsor you to have your head shaved!
- 2** On the big day, head to your local funrazor to have your hair clipped and have a great time!
- 3** If you have people that have sponsored you in cash, you will need to do a bit of banking as well – instructions are on the inside back page of this book.

STEP ONE → DEPOSITING MONEY

Option A | IN PERSON AT ANY WESTPAC BRANCH

Please bank all your sponsorship money in ONE deposit in person at any Westpac branch using this account number:

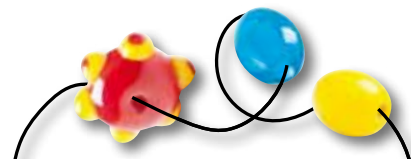
